Worcester Public Library Offers Program to Help Consumers Understand Credit Reports and Scores

Consumers need to be able to understand their credit report and credit score in order to improve their credit ratings and qualify for more favorable terms.

This program will help consumers learn how to read a credit report, and understand how certain variables affect their credit score. It will also help them learn the steps they can take to improve their credit.
