



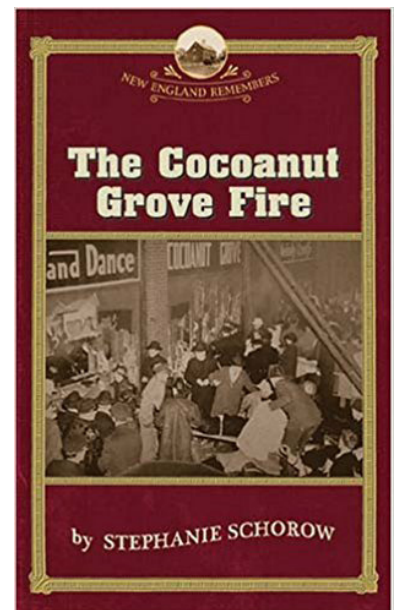
Remembering the Cocoanut Grove Fire with Author Stephanie Schorow

Author Stephanie Schorow will explore the story of the Cocoanut Grove nightclub fire which took place in Boston in November of 1942 and took the lives of nearly 500 people, including many from central Massachusetts. WPI Professor Nicholas A. Dembsey has used the Cocoanut Grove fire as a case study in his fire modeling course, where students used modern fire modeling tools along with fire investigation data to simulate the fire as described by witnesses, he will present their findings.
