The Tatnuck Magnet Branch, 1083 Pleasant St., will be open Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1:30 to 5:30 p.m.; and Tuesday from 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 3 to 7 p.m.
